WHERE IS IT? In the picture perfect Swiss mountain retreat of Gstaad, at the entrance of the village, surrounded by an idyllic park. Accessible by road (90 minutes from Geneva or Berne airports) or by train (direct connections from Geneva airport; the Panoramic Express also stops in Gstaad).

MEETINGS MENU Two charming Alpine chalets connected by enclosed walk way to the Belle Epoque main



building provide 4 meeting spaces, including 2 board rooms for 10, and 2 suites with a capacity for up to 50 people. The two biggest meeting rooms can be combined to accommodate meetings for up to 80. All event suites are spaciouly laid out with floor-to-ceiling windows filling the room with natural light, while the panoramic mountain views offer an inspiring outlook for workaholics. Adjoining south-facing terraces can be used as break-out areas and the hotel provides power yoga sessions which can be specifically arranged.

TECHNO TALK Computer projectors, TV, Video and DVD players and recorders, double projections screens (ideal for multi-lingual presentations), microphones and auto-conferencing are all available. All technical equipment is controlled by a multi-media unit with touch screen (TV, CD, Video, PC, DVD, light dimmer, sound equalizer and automatic curtains). The hotel's AV professionals can set up, operate and dismantle the equipment.

SLEEP TIGHT The hotel has a total of 57 contemporary bedrooms located in the main building as well as in the same chalets that house the conference facilities. The rooms are spacious and tastefully furnished with minimalist Asian-inspired furniture, parquet wooden floors with under-floor heating and luxurious bathrooms, some with freestanding baths and walk-in rain showers. Amenities include wireless broadband, wide-screen Bang & Olufson TV with DVD and CD-player, cable TV, free mini bar. The hotel has three specialty suites (Suite Etoile, Suite Asie and Suite Bellevue) and ten suites with living room area.

FOOD & BEVERAGE The hotel has two award-winning restaurants: The Brasserie Coelho (13 points GaultMillau) offers Swiss classics and international cuisine for up to 80



guests, and the Prado restaurant (16 points GaultMillau and 1 Michelin star) offers French gourmet cuisine for up to 35. An atmospheric wine cellar is available for exclusive wine tasting events for up to 12. For special evening events, the stunning Clubhouse can be hired.

ADDED VALUE Delegates wanting to escape work can relax in the Asian-inspired Bellevue SPA which features a wide variety of baths, heat experiences, pool and a health club.

TEAM BUILDING Surrounded by magnificent Alpine scenery, an adventurous playground lies just on the doorstep. The hotel organizes group-bonding experiences year round. Winter activities include ski tours, snow shoe hiking, sledge rides or a rustic fondue evening and summer activities include mountain biking, white water rafting or paragliding.
